

## **B1 Appendix - *Chemicals***

### **to the Safety sheet for Transportation Companies (Transporters/Freight Forwarders), who drive to/into the premises of Laakirchen Papier AG**

**In addition to the safety sheet mentioned above the following conditions apply for the delivery of chemicals:**

**ad 1.2. Obligatory registration:**

The registration office for drivers is the guard house. The gatekeeper informs the recipient of the chemicals and allocates a parking space to the driver. The driver is picked up by the recipient of the chemicals to clarify further steps.

The instructions from the recipient of the chemicals are to be followed.

**ad 1.3. Wearing personal protective equipment:**

The driver has to wear the protective equipment suitable for the respective category of the product! Wearing of a high visibility vest and protective boots (at least protection category S1 EN 345 European standard) is as a rule necessary on company premises.

**ad 1.4. No Smoking / No Alcohol / No Intoxicants:**

When handling chemicals there is a very strict ban on smoking! That is why there are no zones or other places for smokers in this area!

**ad 3.1. The Highway Code is valid here:**

All regulations in the Highway Code are to be complied with exactly; especially in the case of transportation of hazardous goods compliance with all applicable regulations is to be paid attention to.

After unloading is complete and possible weighing of the empty vehicle carried out, company premises have to be left without delay!

**ad 3.3. Use of safe vehicles:**

Vehicles which do not comply with the guidelines for the transportation of the goods transported do not have a right to be unloaded.

Tools and aids borrowed from Laakirchen Papier AG have to be returned in an unobjectionable condition. Use of such tools and aids is at one's own risk!

**ad 4.1. Noise and air pollution:**

Unnecessary running of the vehicle's engine at the place of unloading is strictly forbidden!

**ad 4.2. Orderliness and Hygiene:**

Sanitary facilities are available for drivers when they are requested for from the recipient of the chemicals.

**ad 4.3. Entry to operational facilities:**

The driver has to permanently monitor downloading and remain close to the vehicle. After unloading, no soiling or contamination may be left behind.

**ad 4.4. Condition of Vehicles:**

The vehicle, the tank or any equipment used for transfer of the chemicals (hosepipe) may not under any circumstances be cleaned on LPA premises!
